

IRON HORSE

All Iron Horse miniskidders now have a drain nipple fitted to the throttle cable to prevent freezing. This nipple may also be fitted to earlier models.

Proceed as follows:

1. Mark the lowest point on the throttle cable. Since water collects at this point it is important that the nipple is correctly placed.
2. Loosen the nipple connecting the cable to the throttle lever on the engine. Pull the cable out of its sheath.
3. Cut away the rubber hose and cable sheath at the point you marked in item 1. Make sure that there are no sharp edges on the sheath that could damage the cable.
4. Place the nipple in the opening you have made and slide both ends of the cable sheath into the nipple. Lock them in place using the stop screws.
5. Feed the cable through the sheath and reconnect the cable to the throttle lever on the motor.

NOTE: In the winter all cables should be lubricated with a glycol-water mixture to prevent freezing.
